In summer 2023, he was a finalist in Grimethorpe Colliery Band's international composition competition with "Skule Overture". His music has been performed throughout Sweden as well as in Europe and North America.

Notable works include the bassoon sonata for award-winning soloist Sebastian Stevensson and the chamber suite "Books on a Bookshelf"; the children's opera "Prins

Pompom" after a story by playwright Alfhild Agrell; a unique Christmas oratorio with an original Swedish libretto; and several vocal and choral works, including several acclaimed settings of Tomas Tranströmer's poetry such as "Romanesque Arches" for mixed choir and "Den stora gåtan" for solo voice and accordion.
